Dear Families,

Further to my earlier communication on 2nd April I wish to let you know that our situation in Cheeverstown has evolved and we now have a small number of confirmed Covid-19 cases among the people we support on campus and a further number of people who, although not confirmed as positive, are nonetheless displaying some of the symptoms for whom we have increased their levels of observation and support. We continue to link closely with the families of people supported in Cheeverstown's campus and community based residential services. We are keeping families informed if their family member shows symptoms which are being monitored on a daily basis.

We are also following the advice we receive on a regular basis from the HSE and the Health Prevention Surveillance Centre, HPSC.

We fully appreciate these are difficult and worrying times for you, your family member and our staff. We thank you for your understanding and support as we continue to combat the challenges that COVID 19 brings.

If you have any specific concerns or queries regarding your family member please get in touch with the manager in your area or your social worker.

Please stay safe and continue to follow the guidelines issued by the Government.
