Update to Families 15th May 2020

Dear Family Member,

I write to thank you for your continued co-operation with Cheeverstown as we support your family member in the safest way possible.

While there are still a small number of residents on campus who have tested positive for COVID 19, these residents continued to be managed very well and staff are supporting these residents in compliance with guidance from the Department of Public Health and the HSE.

Cheeverstown completed the blanket testing of residents to include people who are living in Cheeverstown's community based homes on 8th May 2020. A small number of residents tested positive.

The management team has reviewed the government's guidance to 'Reopening Society and Business' and has reviewed Reopening Phase 1 (from 18th May) as relevant to the current outbreak situation in Cheeverstown.

As there are positive cases of COVID-19, we ask that families respect that there continues to be no visiting which includes small groups meeting outdoors for all of Cheeverstown Campus and in Designated Centre 7.

For Designated Centres 5,6 & 8 and SSDL we ask families to respect that there should be no non-essential visits. With pre planning and approval by management, a short outdoor meeting may be supported. Social distancing, hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette must be adhered to.
